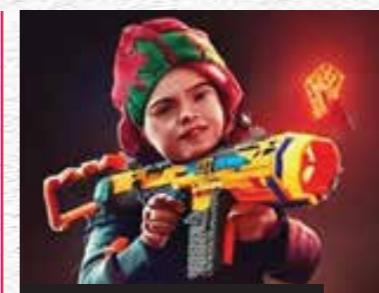
## WEEK SEVEN

Children will get to make their own shrinky dink keychains along with exploring acrylic tile painting with Jackie.

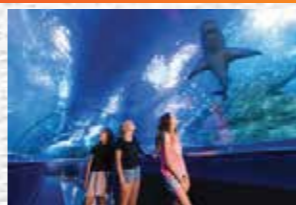


31<sup>ST</sup> JANUARY 2025
